Interior Accommodation:

Satu's custom 'Superyacht' interior is very contemporary and quite unlike any other Sports fishers built to date. Specialist interior designers 'Robinson Marine Interiors' combined the best designer furnishings and bespoke furniture by Christian Liaigre.

Luxuriously appointed and finished to an exceptional standard, her understated styling runs throughout the whole yacht (including crew areas).

Such was the desired attention to detail by her creator that one single Japanese Ash tree was used to create a light and calm interior. The floors throughout the yacht are of dark Wenge hardwood.

In summary SATU'S living space is comfortably appointed and a relaxing environment in which to live and cruise in.

Saloon:

A wide and particularly spacious saloon which is entered through electronic doors from the cockpit. The perfect place in which to relax after a great days fishing or cruising.

Master Guest Cabin:

- The especially large full beam master cabin is forward towards the bow.
- It has a walk round king size double bed and ample space in which to relax.

- As with all of the cabins, cream carpets, white linen and silk tied wall linings create a warm / relaxed environment
- When building SATU, particular attention was given to the sound insulation of each cabin. This is very noticeable and an excellent feature of the yacht.
- Clothes storage surrounding the cabin - ideal for extensive trips onboard
- Large desk and stool makes for a useful office area.
- Designer leather armchair in a corner
- 42" Sony Bravia HDTV & DVD player
- Electrical lift stows the television opposite the foot of the bed

The galley is a sociable area which interacts well with the adjoining saloon. Opposite the galley is a Wenge dinette - ideal for casual dining etc. Adjoining the galley is a large walk-in pantry which houses the boats main fridges.

Cockpit:

- New teak decking (2020).

- An articulating International fighting chair provides rod tip clearance whilst the transom door is large enough to bring in a "grander"!

Ground Tackle & Thruster:

Satu's anchor is superbly hidden below deck. A Rondal fold-out deployment arm hydraulically lifts in and out of a bow locker (thus preserving Satu's superb aesthetics).
